MARCH FINANCIAL REPORT

March income was \$10,514 and expenses were \$17,819 giving us a net income of negative \$7,305 for March and negative \$3,035 for the year-to-date. The larger than usual expenses for the month are due to the moving expenses for our new pastor which were paid in March.

Income in the collection plate is down 28% from this time last year. In order to remain financially solvent, we need everyone's continued support. Hopefully, with a new pastor on board in May our attendance and giving will see an uptick.

A reminder that this year's per-capita is \$50.15 per member. If you're able to pay your own, that will be helpful.





