Cathy Junken Rev. David Rosen Anita Steverson Berta Wenneker **Madison Presbyterian Church**, Sandy Fox, Commissioned Pastor, is downtown, two blocks from the Ohio River. We celebrate 207 years of Presbyterian life and service to the community in 2022. The congregation of 130 plus friends are bound together thru our efforts to Love and Glorify God and Love and Serve Others. Among the programs in which we participate, our service to the children of Jefferson County may be our most important. Weekly, volunteers gather at House of Hope to pack BackSacks (gently used Kroger and Walmart bags). In each bag is an array of food for the children to take home on Friday. The bags are delivered to the schools where the teachers know those children most at risk. We assemble about 220 bags a week (130 last year!). MPC funds the program. We have five new members this year. Monday evening 20 people meet to study God's word, and Tuesday morning 12 Prayer Warriors gather to pray for others. The PNC meets weekly as their search

for a pastor continues. Our CRE leads as we Love and Glorify God and Love and Serve Others.
