The church is debt-free, and for 2023 we approved a balanced budget in which 35% of giving goes to support local missions and ministries of the Presbyterian Church (USA). God's Grace free clothing ministry remains the anchor of our community outreach and efforts served almost 500 children at last summer's back-to-school event. Rev. Dr. Scott Seay has served the church as part-time pastor for fifteen years, and last February the church welcomed a part-time assistant Pastor, Rev. Mac Bellner. Two doctoral students at Jacobs School of Music--Seungkyu Oh and Benjamin Gittens—lead in our music ministry. Small in number but mighty in faithfulness, this congregation strives to discern and participate in God's transforming and renewing work in Brown County.
